The results from the 2024-2025 Smarter Balanced Summative Assessment, California's standardized test, confirm that APLUS+ member schools are effectively closing the achievement gap, particularly among student groups that have historically been underserved by the traditional education system.

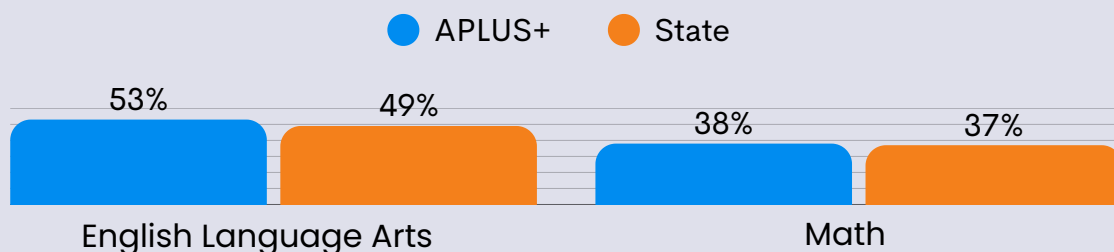

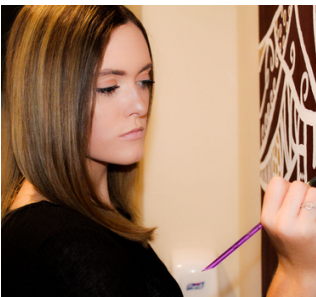

When looking at California's Academic Indicator, which shows Average Distance from Standard, Personalized Learning students made significant gains in both English Language Arts and math on the 2024-25 state test compared to 2023-24. Distance from Standard measures how many points above or below each student is from demonstrating knowledge and skills necessary for students to be on track for college and career readiness at their grade level.
